# **National level Workshop & Review Meeting on Strengthening of Cooperatives**



**The National Level Review Meeting and Workshop with States and UTs was successfully conducted by the Ministry of Cooperation for Strengthening of Cooperative Sector was held on 08.10.2025 & 09.10.2025 at Tirupati, Andhra Pradesh.**

**The event was attended by the Principal Secretaries, Commissioners and Registrars of Cooperative Societies from all States and Union Territories.**



**The Union Territory of Andaman and Nicobar Islands was represented by the Secretary (Cooperation)-cum-Registrar of Cooperative Societies.**

**The workshop emphasized and focused on the vision of “Sahakar se Samruddhi” — achieving prosperity through cooperatives.**

**Discussions were held on Computerization of all PACS, enhancing digital systems, and expanding cooperative services in rural areas.**

**Additionally, several sessions were held on topics such as cashless and paperless operations, strengthening of dairy and fisheries cooperatives, developing new business models and improving export opportunities.**

# COOPERATIVE MOVEMENT IN THE ISLES

Post-independence, cooperatives have played a transformative role in the andaman and nicobar islands, promoting economic empowerment, social upliftment and community development across sectors such as agriculture, fisheries, and tribal welfare.

Cooperative societies provided the foundation for rural finance and modern agricultural practices, supporting settlers and local producers through group credit, thrift and land development initiatives.

The Andaman & Nicobar State Cooperative Bank Ltd. (ANStCB) stands as the apex financial institution of the cooperative credit structure in the Union Territory, serving as a vital pillar in the economic development of the ANI. With 41 Core Banking System (CBS) branches spread across 14 islands and 33 ATMs. The Bank has established its presence even in the remotest corners where nationalized banks are yet to reach, catering to a customer base of over 3 lakh individuals.



Cooperatives have promoted tribal economic self-reliance, notably through Ellon Hinengo Limited (EHL) & Tribal Development Cooperative Society LTD (TDCS).

TDCS has secured Geographical Indication (GI) tags for Virgin Coconut Oil and other local products, boosting market recognition and empowering indigenous communities.



# Computerization of Primary Agricultural Cooperative Societies (PACS)

The Centrally Sponsored Scheme (CSS) for PACS by the Ministry of Cooperation has been successfully implemented across all sanctioned 46 PACS, which are now fully equipped with essential hardware components, including computers, printers, UPS units and scanners, to support digital operations. The National Level PACS Software (NLPS), developed by NABARD (H.O) has been installed and made operational in all societies, enabling seamless management of accounts, transactions and member services.

Legacy data digitization, including member account details has been successfully completed, ensuring smooth transition from manual to digital systems. The implementation of NLPS has brought greater transparency, efficiency and accuracy to the functioning of PACS, marking a significant step towards strengthening the cooperative credit structure in the Islands.

# Computerization of RCS Office

Under the Centrally Sponsored Scheme (CSS) of the Ministry of Cooperation, the Department has procured 10 desktop computers, 04 Multi-Functional Printers and 10 UPS through GeM.

For software development, SOVTECH was entrusted with the development of eight online software modules viz.

- ① Registration of New Cooperative Societies,
- (ii) Amendment of Bye-laws,
- (iii) Inspection of Cooperative Societies,
- (iv) Audit of Cooperative Societies,
- (v) Election of Cooperative Societies,
- (vi) Settlement of Disputes,
- (vii) Liquidation of Cooperative Societies,
- (viii) Appeal for facilitate ease of access and ensure timely disposal of proposals received from the public and registered cooperative societies.

The project aims to streamline administrative processes, enhance transparency and improve service delivery. It will significantly modernize the functioning of the Registrar's Office and facilitate better support to cooperative societies.



# KESARI LABOUR CONTRACT COOPERATIVE SOCIETY LTD

Kesari Labour Contract Cooperative Society Ltd., Mayabunder is a labour cooperative primarily engaged in stevedoring operations at dockyards. The society plays a critical role in ensuring smooth cargo handling. Being a cooperative, it is democratically managed by its member-workers, ensuring fair wages, transparency, and shared responsibility by providing livelihood to around 80 members.

In addition to dockyard labour, the cooperative undertakes various semi-private contracts, such as:

- Material shifting and handling for industrial units.
- Labour supply for construction support activities.
- Event-related manpower, cleaning, and utility work for private organisations.
- Minor civil labour and maintenance tasks for institutions or local bodies.

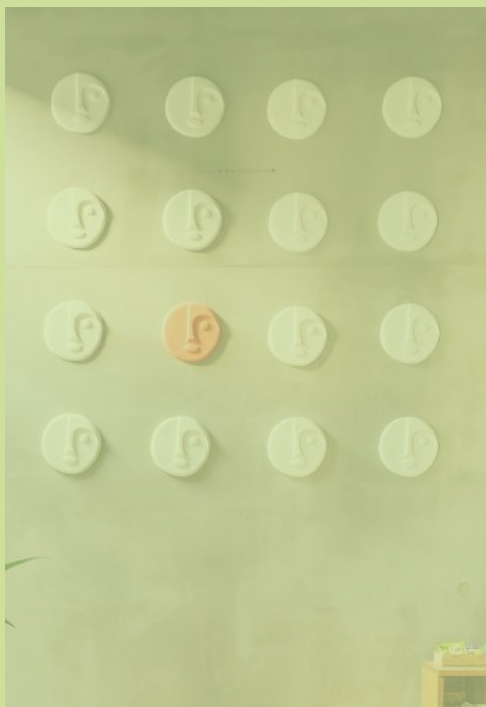


The Cooperative maintains profitability by:

- Stable revenue from dock operations.
- Elimination of middlemen AS members work directly through the society, reducing commission leakages and improving overall earnings.
- Flexible workforce allocation.
- Cost-effective operations such as shared resources, rotational labour deployment.
