The 20 Rupee Note Depicts A Scene From Andaman And Nicobar Islands





Prashasan Gaon Ki Ore



Andaman and Nicobar Islands have India's best nesting beaches for three species of marine turtles -Hawksbill, Green turtle and world's largest sea turtle, the Leatherback (Dermocheleys Coriacea). The nesting population of Leatherback turtles in Nicobar is one of the few colonies that exceeds 1,000 individuals in the Indo-Pacific, and is hence of global importance.

DEMARCATION OF LAND, MUTATION OF LAND BECOMES ONLINE.

Shri Keshav Chandra, IAS, Chief Secretary, A&N Islands and Shri Devesh Chandra Srivastva, IPS, Director General of Police, A&N Police of Andaman and Nicobar Islands virtually launched the Online Web Portal on 1st July 2024 for Mutation & Demarcation, Integration of the Land Registration Portal with the Mutation Module, and Verification of Tenant/Domestic help which were much anticipated for enhancing digital accessibility and service delivery in the region. The Andaman & Nicobar become 1st Union Territory to integrate registration & mutation in end to end management. This initiative aligns with the Administration's commitment to leveraging technology to streamline processes and make public services more accessible and user-friendly.

In his inaugural address, the Chief Secretary, A&N Islands highlighted the importance of the Online Web Portal in public administration. He emphasized the convenience and efficiency that the services will bring to the residents of A&N Islands, stating, "This initiative is a testament to our dedication to improving service delivery through technology. The services will empower citizens providing them easy access to mutation and demarcation services, eliminating the need for physical visits, and saving valuable time and resources."

The Administration remains committed to further improving and expanding the digital services available through the Web Portal. The Online Web Portal for Mutation & Demarcation and Integration of the Land Registration Portal with the Mutation Module has been developed by the National Informatics Centre, South Andaman District, and the verification of tenant/domestic help portal by SOVTECH.








Commemoration Of 81st Anniversary of First Flag Hoisting in Andaman & Nicobar Islands On 30th Dec 2024

Issuance Of Ayushman Bharat Card At ITF. | Control of the control

The Government of India aims to provide a significant healthcare benefit to senior citizens aged 70 years and above through the AB-PMJAY (Ayushman Bharat Pradhan Mantri Jan Arogya Yojana) initiative. This policy ensures that eligible senior citizens receive cashless treatment worth up to Rs 5 lakh for medical expenses.

The key eligibility criterion for this scheme is simple: the individual must be 70 years or older, with the age determined as per the Aadhaar Card. This is a significant move, as the policy covers all senior citizens, regardless of their economic status, meaning that the benefits are available to everyone in this age group, whether or not they are below or above the poverty line.

This initiative will greatly enhance access to healthcare for senior citizens in A&N Islands, allowing them to receive necessary medical treatments without financial strain. The District Administration aims to ensure that every eligible individual is enrolled and has easy access to this vital healthcare coverage, promoting their well-being and reducing out-of-pocket healthcare expenses for the elderly population.



Awareness Of Online Services At ITF

The District Administration has transitioned its service delivery to an online platform to improve efficiency and accessibility. 
The only active volcano in India, the Barren Island, is present in Andaman Islands




Barren Island is the only active volcano not just in India but the whole of South Asia. Located approximately 135 km north east of Port Blair, this small 3-km-wide island contains a 1.6-km-wide crater partially filled by a cinder cone that has been the source of eruptions since the first was recorded in 1787.

Issuance Of E-Epic At ITF







The District Administration , South Andamanparticipated in the National level Mock Exercise on 5th Nov 2024 ofIndian Tsunami Early Warning Centre, Indian National Centre for Ocean Information Service (INCOIS), Ministry of Earth Science, Gol, Hyderabad in coordination with National Disaster Management Authority, New Delhi conducted the National Tsunami Mock Exercise today in all Coastal States/UTs of India coinciding with World Tsunami Awareness Day. The exercise was conducted in different locations of A&N Islands wherein people of A&N Islands and all Emergency Support Functionaries (Police, Fire, Health, Electricity, Shipping, SVPMC, PMB, APWD, Civil supply, IP&T etc.) Emergency Operation Centres, District Administrations, A&N Command, NDRF and other Stakeholders of A&N Administration participated.

During the exercise, the India Tsunami Early Warning Centre (ITEWC) at Indian National Centre for Ocean Information Services (INCOIS), Hyderabad started by sending message of simulated tsunami threat information as an occurrence of Gigantic Earthquake measuring 9.3Mw in Richter scale near Northern Sumatra at 0930 hrs and was followed by Tsunami generation and issue of alerts/warning in the form of bulletins

to all coastal States of India including ANI.

These alert/warnings/advices/threat were disseminated from State Emergency Operation Centre (SEOC) through different means of communication channels to all Emergency Operation Centres and Control Rooms of line Departments of A&N Islands. This exercise was completed after receipt of All Clear Message at 1330 hrs. from INCOIS, Hyderabad, a press release from Directorate of Disaster Management said.





Katchal Island received the first sun rise of the millennium



Katchal, a tiny island near Nicobar was virtually unknown till the Royal Greenwich Laboratory declared that it would be the first inhabited place on earth to catch the rays of the first sunrise of the millennium. In the first postal issue of the year 2000, India Post issued a commemorative stamp depicting the first sunrise of the millennium at Katchal.



Health Sector (NRHM) Kuposhan Mukt And Anemia Mukt District Abhiyan



The 'Kuposhan Mukt and Anemia Mukt District Abhiyaan' was launched in Port Blair to combat malnutrition and anemia in the South Andaman District. The initiative was inaugurated by Shri Arjun Sharma, IAS, Deputy Commissioner (SA), Shri L. Kumar, IAS, Secretary of Social Welfare, and Shri Anand Vardhan Mishra, Director I/c, Social Welfare. They distributed nutritional kits to malnourished children and anemic women. This campaign, coordinated by the ICDS, Directorate of Social Welfare, and Directorate of Health Services, and supported by NGOs, represents a significant effort to improve health and address nutritional deficiencies among vulnerable populations in the region. The Kuposhan Mukt District Abhiyaan aims to combat malnutrition by providing comprehensive support to malnourished children and pregnant women through the distribution of nutrient-rich diet kits.


Health Sector (NRHM) Kuposhan Mukt And Anemia Mukt District Abhiyan

Jal Hans, India's first commercial seaplane was launched in the Andaman Islands



Sea planes are amphibious aircrafts that can take off and land on water and as well as on land. Calling it the Jal Hans, government-owned Pawan Hans launched India's first seaplane operation in Andaman and Nicobar Islands in 2013. Jal Hans is an eight seater Cessna 208 A that is fitted with modern navigation features, can travel up to 250 km in an hour and can also land on ground.

PM TB Mukt Bharat Abhiyan




The District Health Society under the aegis of South Andaman District Administration conducted a camp at Khaitan Kalyana Mandapam, Junglighat and distributed nutritional kits to TB patients under the Pradhan Mantri TB Mukt Bharat Abhiyan. Shri Arjun Sharma, IAS, Deputy Commissioner (South Andaman), distributed nutritional kits to TB patients at an event held at Kahitan Kalyana M a n d a p , Junglighat. The programme aimed to motivate the community to adopt TB patients and raise awareness about TB prevention, early detection, and treatment. In his address, Shri Arjun Sharma emphasized the collective responsibility in the fight against TB. He highlighted the importance of early diagnosis, consistent treatment, and active c o m m u n i t y participation to eradicate the disease. Shri Sharma stressed that addressing the social stigma associated with TB is equally crucial, as fostering awareness and c o m m u n i t y engagement can significantly reduce the disease's prevalence and improve patient outcomes. Additionally, the DC (SA) shared that 49 Nikshay Mitras have already registered under the initiative and presently 133 TB patients have been adopted under South Andaman District. 15th National Voters Day Celebrated in A&N Islands with the Theme 'Nothing Like Voting, I Vote for Sure'




