No. /F. No. 2-9(2)/2022-PR. In exercise of the powers conferred by the proviso to Article 309 of the Constitution of India, read with the Government of India, Ministry of Home Affairs, New Delhi, Notification No. U-14039/2/83-ANL dated 21/02/1985, and Govt. of India, Ministry of Personnel, Pubic Grievances and Pensions (Department of Personnel & Training), New Delhi OM No. AB-14017/12/87-Estt (RR) dated 18-3-1988 and with the approval of UPSC, New Delhi vide their letter and in supersession of the Recruitment Rules of the post of Chief Accounts Officer Notified vide Administration's Notification No. 119/03 dated 14.07.2003, the Hon'ble Lieutenant Governor (Administrator), Andaman & Nicobar Islands, hereby proposes to makes the following rules regulating the method Recruitment Rules for Group 'A' post of Chief Accounts Officer borne in the establishment of Zilla Parishad, South Andaman under the Panchayati Raj institutions of Andaman and Nicobar Islands, namely:-

The objections and suggestions are invited by stake holders/persons to be affected thereby. The objections and suggestion (if any) should reach the Assistant Secretary (RD), A&N Administration within 30 days from the date of its publication in the official website.

1. Short title and commencement

- i. These Rules may be called the Union Territory of Andaman and Nicobar Islands Chief Accounts Officer, Zilla Parishad, South Andaman in Panchayati Raj Institutions Group 'A' Recruitment Rules, 2025.
- ii. They shall come into force on the date of their publication in the Official Gazette.

2. Number of posts, classifications and scale of pay:

The number of the said posts, their classification and scale of pay attached thereto, shall be as specified in paras 2 to 4 of the Schedule annexed to these rules.

3. Method of Recruitment, age limit and qualifications etc:

The method of recruitment, age limit, qualifications and others matter relating to the said post shall be as specified in paras 5 to 13 of the schedule aforesaid.

4. <u>Disqualification:</u>-

No person-

- (a) who has entered into or contract a marriage with any person having a spouse living; or
- (b) who having a spouse living as entered into or contracted a marriage with any person;

Shall be eligible for appointed to the said post:

Provided that the Hon'ble Lieutenant Governor (Administrator), Andaman and Nicobar Islands may, if satisfied that such marriage is permissible is under the personal law applicable to such person and the other party to the marriage and there are other grounds for so doing, exempt any person from the operation of this Rule.

5. Power to relax:

Where the Hon'ble Lieutenant Governor (Administrator), Andaman and Nicobar Islands is of the opinion that it is necessary or expedient so to do, he may, By order and for the reasons to be recorded in writing relax any of the provision of these rules with respect to any class or category of persons.

6. Savings:

Nothing in his rules shall affect reservation, relaxation of age limit and other concessions required to be provided for the candidates belong to the Schedule castes, Schedule Tribes and other specified categories of persons in accordance with the orders issued by the Central Government from time to time in this regard.
