

PRESS NOTE
ENGAGEMENT OF RESOURCE PERSONS AT MAHATMA GANDHI GOVT. COLLEGE
MAYABUNDER.

As approved by A & N Administration, vide e-File No. A-12024/3/2023-DIV-Section Sectt-Part (1) and F. No. 7-28/2017-D-IV dated 28/04/2025, Mahatma Gandhi Govt. College, Mayabunder, proposes to prepare a panel of Resource Persons to utilize their services as Guest Faculty in the following subjects to teach U.G. courses **as and when required basis** for the academic session 2025-26.

The Resource Person shall be paid honorarium / remuneration Rs. 1,500/- (Rupees One Thousand Five Hundred only) per lecture subject to a maximum of Rs.50,000/- (Rupees Fifty Thousand only) or as per the instruction received from the Competent Authority as the case may be.

(i) Physical Education

Educational and other qualifications

Essential

1. A Master's degree with 55% marks (or an equivalent grade in a point scale wherever the grading system is followed) in a concerned / relevant/allied subject from a recognized Indian University/Institute.
2. The candidate must have cleared the National Eligibility Test (NET) conducted by the UGC or the CSIR, or who are or have been awarded a Ph.D. Degree in accordance with the University Grants Commission (Minimum Standards and Procedure for Award of M.Phil / Ph.D. Degree) Regulations 2009 or 2016 and their amendments from time to time as the case may be exempted from NET. *Provided*, the candidates registered for the Ph.D. programme prior to July 11, 2009, shall be governed by the provisions of the then existing Ordinances/Bye-laws/Regulations of the Institution awarding the degree and such Ph.D. candidates shall be exempted from the requirements of NET for engagement as Resource Person in M.G. Govt. College subject to the fulfillment of the following conditions:-
 - a) The Ph.D. degree of the candidate has been awarded in a regular mode;
 - b) The Ph.D. thesis has been evaluated by at least two external examiners;
 - c) An open Ph.D. viva voce of the candidate has been conducted;
 - d) The candidate has published two research papers from his/her Ph.D. work, out of which at least one is in a refereed journal;
 - e) The candidate has presented at least two papers based on his/her Ph.D. work in conferences/seminar sponsored/funded/supported by the UGC/ICSSR/CSIR or any similar agency.

The fulfillment of the conditions (a) to (e) as above is to be certified by the Registrar or the Dean (Academic Affairs) of the university concerned.

Note-1: NET/SLET/SET shall also not be required for such Masters Programmes in disciplines for which NET is not conducted by the UGC/CSIR.

Note-2: A relaxation of 5% shall be provided Bachelor's and Master's Level for the candidate belonging to Scheduled Caste/Scheduled Tribes/Other Backward Classes (OBC) (Non-creamy Layer)/Differently-abled: (A) Blindness and Low vision; (B) Deaf and Hard of Hearing; (C) Locomotors Disability including Cerebral Palsy, Leprosy cured, Dwarfism, Acid Attack Victims and Muscular Dystrophy; (D) Autism, Intellectual Disability – Specific Learning Disabilities and Mental Illness; (E) Multiple Disabilities from amongst persons under (A) to (D) including deaf-blindness for the purpose of eligibility. The eligibility marks of 55% (or an equivalent grade in a point scale wherever grading is followed) and the relaxation of 5% to the categories mentioned above are permissible, based only on the qualifying marks without including any grace mark procedures.

Note-3: The concerned/relevant subject/discipline shall be specified as per requirement at the time of the recruitment.

The eligible candidates are advised to submit hard copy of a brief personal data along with related documents to the office of the Principal, M.G. Govt. College Mayabunder – 744204, Andaman & Nicobar Islands on or before **30.08.2025**. Application received after due date will not be entertained. General Terms and Conditions

1. The engagement of resource persons is purely on 'as and when required' basis and they shall have no claim for extension of the term or right for any part time/regular post in the department at any point of time.
2. In case of resignation of the position/leaving the institute, one should intimate to Office of the Principal at least 15 (fifteen) days prior to leaving the college or return/deposit 15 days honorarium to the Govt. Account.
3. If any resource person is absent from duty without prior written intimation to the HoD concerned/ principal, the next candidate shall be engaged for teaching the classes. In such case the resource person shall not have any claim for his further engagement as resource person.
4. If situation warrants, the resource person should engage additional classes. If he/she is not willing to take additional classes, the candidate in the panel who is willing to take additional class will be engaged as resource person.
5. For counting of honorarium, the report submitted by HoD concerned stating the classes were conducted by the Resource Person shall be treated as final.
6. As the medium of instruction is in English, the resource person is expected to deliver lecture in English.
