

PRESS NOTE

The Department of Fisheries, A&N Administration is implementing a subsidy programme, "Supply of Fishing Inputs- Essential Fishery Requisite" under the UT Plan Scheme – for the bonafide fishermen of A&N Islands.

The pattern of subsidy and eligibility criteria for the programme of the scheme are as under: -

Pattern of Subsidy for	Pattern of Subsidy for
<u>Non-Tribal Category</u>	<u>Tribal Category</u>
50% of the unit cost with a ceiling of Rs.1500/- per non-motorized Fishing Boat and Rs.3000/- per Motorized Fishing Boats.	75% of the unit cost with a ceiling of Rs.2200/- per non-motorized Fishing Boat and Rs.4300/- per Motorized Fishing Boats.
<u>Eligibility Criteria:</u>	
Applicant should be a bonafide fisherman/Tribe of A & N Islands possessing registered non-motorized / motorized fishing craft and holding a valid fishing license for two consecutive years including the current year.	

Applications are invited from Bonafide fishermen of Municipal and Tribal areas interested in the Procurement of fishing inputs- 'Essential fishery requisite' during 2026-27. Application form and detailed terms & conditions of the scheme can be obtained from the Directorate of Fisheries / Zonal Fisheries Offices (N&M Andaman/South Andaman/Nicobar) and nearest Fisheries Sub Stations. The applications completed in all respect should reach the nearest Fisheries Zonal Office / Sub – Stations on or before 30/06/2026.
