NOTIFICATION

No. 251/2026/ e-F. No. M/19/2026-ACLM-DCSCA-CSCA_AN.— Whereas Draft Rules issued vide Notification No. 225/2026 dated 23rd July, 2026 were published as required by Sub-Section 4 of Section 53 of the Legal Metrology Act, 2009 in the Andaman and Nicobar Gazette, Extra Ordinary dated 23rd July, 2026, inviting objections and suggestions from persons likely to be effected thereby before the expiry of thirty days from the date of publication.

And, whereas, no objections and suggestions were received on the said Draft Rules by the Lt. Governor (Administrator), Andaman and Nicobar Islands.

Now, therefore, in exercise of the powers conferred by Section 53 of the Legal Metrology Act, 2009 read with clause (q) of Section 2 thereof and after consultation with the Central Government, the Lt. Governor (Administrator), Andaman and Nicobar Islands hereby makes the following amendments in the rules having due regard to the conditions stipulated in Sub-Section (4) of Section 53 of the said Act, namely :—

The Andaman & Nicobar Islands Legal Metrology (Enforcement) (Amendment) Rules, 2026

1. Short title and commencement –

(i) These Rules may be called the Andaman and Nicobar Islands Legal Metrology (Enforcement) (Amendment) Rules, 2026.

(ii) It shall come into force from the date of Notification in the Official Gazette.

2. Sub-rule (3) of Rule 9 of the Andaman and Nicobar Islands Legal Metrology (Enforcement) Rules, 2011 (hereinafter referred to as the Principle Rule), shall be substituted as below :-

“(3) Only beam scale of class A or class B category or a non-automatic weighing instrument of high accuracy class (class II) or special accuracy class (class I) having verification scale interval of 1mg, shall be used in any transaction referred to in sub-rules (1) and (2).”

3. Rule 11 of the Principle Rule, shall be substituted as below :-

Registration of manufacturer, repairer and dealer of Weights and Measure”

“(1) Every manufacturer or repairer of, or dealer in, weight or measure shall make an application for the issue of a registration certificate to the Controller legal metrology or such other officer as may be authorized by him in this behalf, in the appropriate form set out in Schedule II-A :

Provided that no registration certificate to repair shall be required by a manufacturer to repair weight or measure manufactured by him and used in a state other than the state of manufacture of the same, but the manufacturer has to inform in advance the concerned legal metrology officer about the repairing :

Provided that the registration certificate issued to the manufacturer, repairer or dealer shall be on the basis of self-declaration by the applicant without requiring any physical inspection :

Provided that every manufacturer or dealer shall furnish the model approval, if applicable, obtained from the Director Legal Metrology, Government of India or the Controller of any of the State"

"(2) Every registration certificate issued to a manufacturer, repairer or dealer shall be in the appropriate form set out in Schedule III."

"(3) Every registration certificate issued to a manufacturer, repairer or dealer on payment of the prescribed fees as specified in the Schedule IV shall, unless make changes in address, gets suspended or cancelled in accordance with the provisions of these rules, be valid for the lifetime of the registered party. Such registration certificate shall not require periodic renewal, subject to continued compliance with the provisions of the Legal Metrology Act, 2009 and the Rules made there under."

"(4) The fee payable for the alteration of a registration certificate or for the issue of a duplicate registration certificate shall be one half of the registration fee as specified in Schedule IV."

"(5) The Controller or such other officer as may be authorized by him in this behalf shall maintain a register of registered manufacturers, dealers and repairers in the form set out in Schedule V."

"(6) Every manufacturer / repairer / dealer registered under the Act and these rules shall maintain such workshop / equipments / tools / registers etc. as the case may be, as per the terms and conditions of the registration certificate."

"(7) Every repairer registered under the Act and these rules shall furnish a security deposit for each registration certificate to the State Government as specified in Schedule VI."

"(8) Every registration certificate issued or renewed under this Act shall be displayed in a conspicuous place in the premises where the registered party carries on business."

"(9) A registration certificate issued under this Act shall not be sellable nor transferable."

4. Rule 12 of the Principle Rule, shall be substituted as below :-

"12. Suspension and cancellation of registration certificate granted"

"(1) The Controller or such other officer authorized by him on behalf may, if he has any reasonable cause to believe that the holder of any registration certificate issued under this Act has made any statement in, or in relation to, any application for the issue of the registration certificate, which is incorrect or false in any material particular or has contravened any provision of the Act or any rule or order made there under, suspend such registration certificate, pending the completion of any inquiry against the holder of such registration certificate :

Provided that no such registration certificate shall be suspended unless the holder thereof has been given a reasonable opportunity of showing cause against the proposed action :

Provided further that where the inquiry referred to in this Sub- section is not completed within a period of three months from the date of suspension of a registration certificate, such suspension shall, on the expiry of the period aforesaid, stand vacated."

"(2) The Controller or such other officer authorized by him on behalf may, if he is satisfied, after making such inquiry as he may think fit, that the holder of a registration certificate has made a false or incorrect statement of the nature referred to in sub-rule (1), or has contravened any law or order referred to in that Sub-section, cancel such registration certificate :

Provided that no such registration certificate shall be cancelled unless the holder thereof has been given a reasonable opportunity of showing cause against the proposed action."

"(3) Every person whose registration has been suspended shall, immediately after such suspension, stop functioning as such registered party and shall not resume business as such registered party until the order of such suspension has been, or stands, vacated."

“(4) Every registered party whose registration certificate has been suspended or cancelled shall, after such suspension or cancellation, as the case may be, surrender such registration certificate to the authority by which such registration certificate was issued.”

“(5) Every registered party whose registration certificate has been cancelled shall, within a period of thirty days from the date of such cancellation, or within such further period, not exceeding three months from such date, as the Controller or such other officer authorized by him on his behalf may, on sufficient cause being shown, allow, dispose of the weights or measures which were in his possession, custody or control on the date of such cancellation and in the event of his failure to do so, the Controller or any other officer authorized by him, in writing, in this behalf, may seize and dispose of the same and distribute the proceeds thereof in such manner as may be prescribed.”

5. Sub-rule (1) of Rule 15 of the Principle Rule, shall be substituted below :-

“(1) Every person using any weight or measure in any transaction or for protection shall present such weight or measure for verification / re-verification, at the office of the Legal Metrology Officer or at such other place as the Legal Metrology Officer may specify in this behalf on or before the date on which the verification falls due :

Provided that where any weight or measure is such that it cannot, or should not be moved from its location, the person using such weight or measure shall report to the Legal Metrology Officer at least thirty days in advance of the date on which the verification falls due :

Provided that verification & stamping of weights and measures falling under “Requiring Self-Certification” as specified under Schedule XII shall be done on the basis of self-certification by the applicant in the format prescribed in Form A of Schedule XII and furnish the same to the Legal Metrology Department as per the verification time prescribed in this Rule :

Provided that verification & stamping of weights and measures falling under “Requiring third party certification” as specified under Schedule XII shall be carried out either at the office of the Legal Metrology Officer or at such other place as the Legal Metrology Officer may specify in this behalf on or before the date on which the verification falls due or carried out on the basis of third party certification by a registered repairer duly authorized by Director Legal Metrology or Controller of any State in the format prescribed in Form B of Schedule XII and furnish the same to the Legal Metrology Department as per the verification time interval prescribed in this Rule subject to fulfillment of all technical criteria by the registered repairer as prescribed under the Legal Metrology Act, 2009 and Rules framed there under.”

6. Sub-rule (1) of Rule 17 of the Principle Rule, shall be substituted as below :-

“(1) Fees payable for verification and stamping of weight or measure at the office or camp office of the Legal Metrology Officer shall be as specified in Schedule IX. Provided that no verification & stamping fees shall be charged from registered Fair Price Shop (FPS) dealers”
