NOTIFICATION

No. /F.No 42-722/2026-TR In exercise of the powers conferred by the proviso to Article 309 of the Constitution of India, read with the Government of India, Ministry of Home Affairs, New Delhi, Notification No. U-14039/2/83-ANL dated 21.02.1985, and in pursuance of DoPT's OM No. AB.14017/13/2016-Estt.(RR) dated 9.08.2016, the Lieutenant Governor (Administrator), Andaman & Nicobar Islands, hereby makes the following amendments to the Recruitment Rules to Group ' B ' Gazetted post of **Manager (Port Signal & Operations)** in the establishment of Port Management Board Andaman & Nicobar Administration published in the A & N Extraordinary Gazette Notification No154/2015/F. No. 42-722/2010-TR. Dated 19.08.2015

1. SHORT TITLE AND COMMENCEMENT:-

(i) These Rules may be called the Union Territory of Andaman and Nicobar Administration **Manager (Port Signal & Operations)** Recruitment (Amendment) Rules, 2026.

(ii) They shall come into force on the date of their publication in the Official Gazette.

AMENDMENTS

2. (i) The existing Column-4 of the Schedule I appended to the Recruitment Rules (herein after called for brevity as the 'said Recruitment Rules') shall be substituted as under:-

Level in the Pay Matrix	Level-7 (₹ 44900-142400) in Pay Matrix
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(ii) The existing entries against column-11 of the Schedule I Shall be substituted as under:-

Promotion: From amongst the Signal Superintendent working in Port Management Board in Pay Matrix Level-6 (Rs, 35400-112400) with 5 years regular service in the grade and have undergone training in managerial skills conducted by Indian Maritime University or any Institute recognized by the Government Note:1 Where juniors who have completed their qualifying/eligibility service are being considered for promotion, their seniors would also be considered provided they are not short of the requisite qualifying/ eligibility service by more than half of such qualifying/eligibility service or two years. whichever is less, and have successfully completed their probation period for promotion to the next higher grade alongwith their juniors who have already completed such qualifying/eligibility service
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Note:2 For the purpose of computing minimum qualifying service for promotion, the service rendered on a regular basis by an officer prior to 01.01.2006/the date from which revised pay structure based on the Sixth Central Pay Commission recommendations has 'been extended, shall be deemed to be service rendered in the corresponding Grade Pay/Pay Scale extended based on the recommendations of the Pay Commission

Deputation (ISTC):

Officers under the Central/State Governments/ UTs/ Universities/ Recognized Research Institutions /Public Sector Undertakings/ Semi-Government /Statutory or Autonomous Bodies including Port Trusts/Dockyards/Shipyards:

(a)(I) Holding analogous posts on a regular basis in the parent cadre/department,

OR

II) With five years' regular service in grade rendered after appointment thereto on a regular basis in Pay Matrix Level-6 (Rs, 35400-112400) or equivalent in the parent cadre/department; and

b)Possessing the following educational qualifications and experience

(i) Degree from a recognized University

(ii) Certificate of proficiency in GOC in GMDSS issued under IMO Convention;

(iii) Three years experience in managing Port Communication Centre/Station

Proficiency in GOC means: Proficiency in General Operating Certificate

The departmental officers in the feeder category who are in the direct line of promotion will not be eligible for consideration for appointment or deputation /absorption. Similarly, deputationist shall not be eligible for consideration for appointment by promotion.

[Period of deputation (ISTC) including period of deputation (ISTC) in another ex-cadre post held immediately preceding this appointment in the same or some other organization /department of the Central Government shall ordinarily not to exceed three years. The maximum age limit for appointment by deputation (ISTC) shall not be exceeding 56 years as on the closing date of receipt of applications]

Note: For the purpose of appointment on deputation (ISTC) basis, the service rendered on a regular basis by an officer prior to 01.01.2006/the date from which the revised pay structure based on the 6th CPC recommendations has been extended, shall be deemed to be service rendered in the corresponding grade pay/pay scale extended based on the recommendations of the Pay Commission except where there has been merger of more than one pre-revised scale of pay into one grade with a common grade pay/pay scale, and where this benefit will extend only for the post(s) for which that grade pay/pay scale is the normal replacement grade without any up-gradation
